



SUBJECT: Continuity of Learning During the School Closure

Dear District 66 Community:

We would like to provide updated information to families on what to expect in the coming weeks during the school closure. **Students are not to attend school in person until April 6.**

Schedule through April 6

As was announced on Friday, we have begun our e-Learning schedule below:

- **March 16** - Students do not report to school.
The purpose is to maintain a continuity of learning. By implementing an e-learning day for March 16, we do not need to make up this day at the end of the school year. We do not need to make up the days where continuity of learning is occurring from March 17 - 27 as the governor has declared them as "Act of God" days.
- **March 17 - 27** - Continuity of learning days
- **March 30** - April 3 - Spring Break
- **April 6** - School resumes with regular schedule

All activities and athletics have been canceled for these three weeks. BACC will also be closed from Monday, March 16 through spring break. BACC will reopen on Monday, April 6.

Please look for e-mail communications that were sent out by individual building principals earlier today for more detailed information on each school's expectations for continued learning during the closure.
