Nominations are now open for the **2019-2020** school year. Completed nomination forms must be received by **no later than Friday, December 21**. We only accept nominations for students that are currently in 2nd through 7th grades. Please complete the parent nomination form if you believe your child is performing, or shows the potential for performing, at remarkably high levels of accomplishment when compared with others of their age, experience, or environment, and you would like your child's performance and achievement to be reviewed to determine eligibility for gifted education services. No action is needed if your child is already receiving gifted services.
